#### General Rules:

1. Players will start with a maximum of 50,000 in tournament chips:
  - a. 20,000 for a \$100 buy-in plus \$50 donation
  - b. 15,000 bonus for early online registration
  - c. 15,000 add-on for a \$50 donation (players not receiving the early registration bonus may take two add-ons to complete a maximum 50K starting stack)
2. Any players who have registered but are not present by the end of the break following Level 6 will have a seat assigned and blinds and antes will be taken beginning with the start of Level 7.
3. Players may re-enter the tournament if they are eliminated prior to the end of Level 12 (no limit on the number of re-entries). Players must receive a "Re-Entry" card from floor person after being eliminated and take to registration table to Re-Enter.
  - a. During the break following Level 12, players have the option to forfeit their remaining chips and re-enter as though they were eliminated.
4. Re-entries will be sold as follows:
  - a. 20,000 for a \$100 buy-in plus \$50 donation
  - b. 30,000 chip optional add-on for \$100 donation
5. During the break following Level 12, all players will have the option to take an additional 30,000 chip add-on for \$100. This will be split, \$50 to the prize pool and \$50 donation.
  - a. For players re-entering at this time, this add-on is available in addition to the add-on taken with the re-entry.
6. Levels will last 15 minutes each through level 18; 20 minutes each from level 19 onward (all times and blind levels are subject to adjustment at the discretion of the Tournament Director).
7. The Tournament Director will have the final say in all matters concerning the length of play in the tournament.
8. There will be a redraw for seats and tables at final 27 and 10 players, or at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
9. This tournament will use the big blind ante. Rather than all players posting antes, the player posting the big blind will also post one ante for the entire table, equal in amount to the big blind. This amount may be reduced at the Tournament Director's discretion when all remaining tables have 7 players or fewer.
10. Tournament Director's Association ([www.pokertda.com](http://www.pokertda.com)) rules will be followed whenever possible, unless superseded by any noted "house rules." Unusual circumstances may dictate that decisions in the interest of fairness and the best interest of the game take priority over the technical rules. The Floor Staff's or Tournament Director's decisions are final and without recourse.
11. Players, by full and mutual agreement among all remaining players, may opt for an adjusted payout structure once the number of players remaining is equal to or less than the total number of places to be paid.
